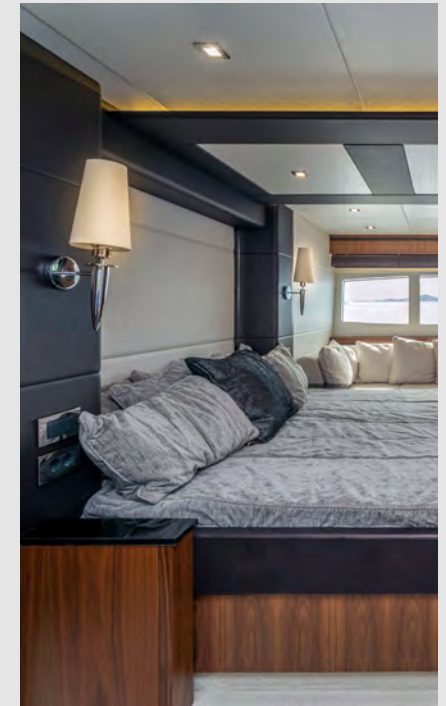


'A Cloudy Bay' is the only Manhattan 73 on the market fitted with the bigger MTU engines. She is also fitted with an impressive list of extras, including hard top, two generators, fin stabilizers, x2 JMS, water maker, SAT TV, Bose system, etc. The interior is a one off, unique design. The black American walnut satin finish with wenge timber planks flooring in the saloon, dining and helm area highlight the sophistication of the yacht's interior. 'A Cloudy Bay' has been a family boat and always maintained to a great standard by the captain and crew.

The boat has 4 beautiful cabins for 8 guests and with additional crew cabin for 2. Owners master cabin has the full beam layout and is located amidship. The rest of the accommodation comprise of forward VIP cabin, a double Guest Cabin to starboard and twin Guest cabin on the port side.

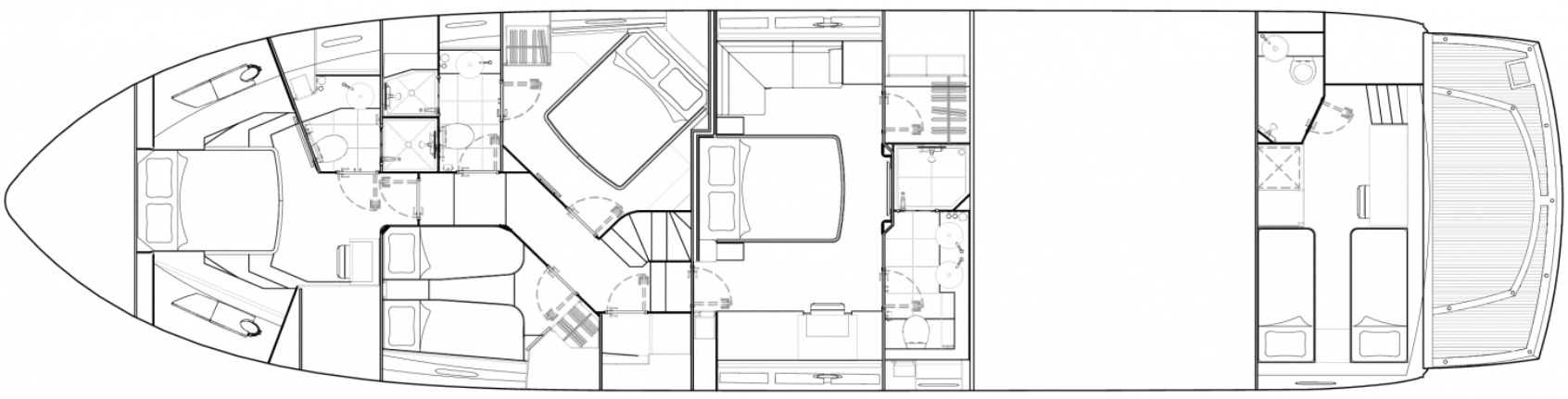
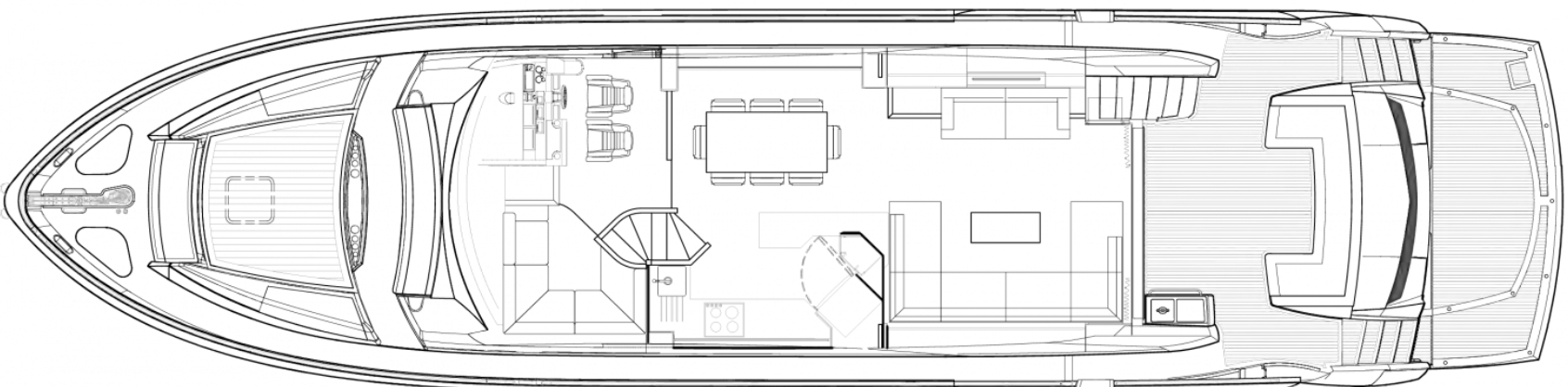
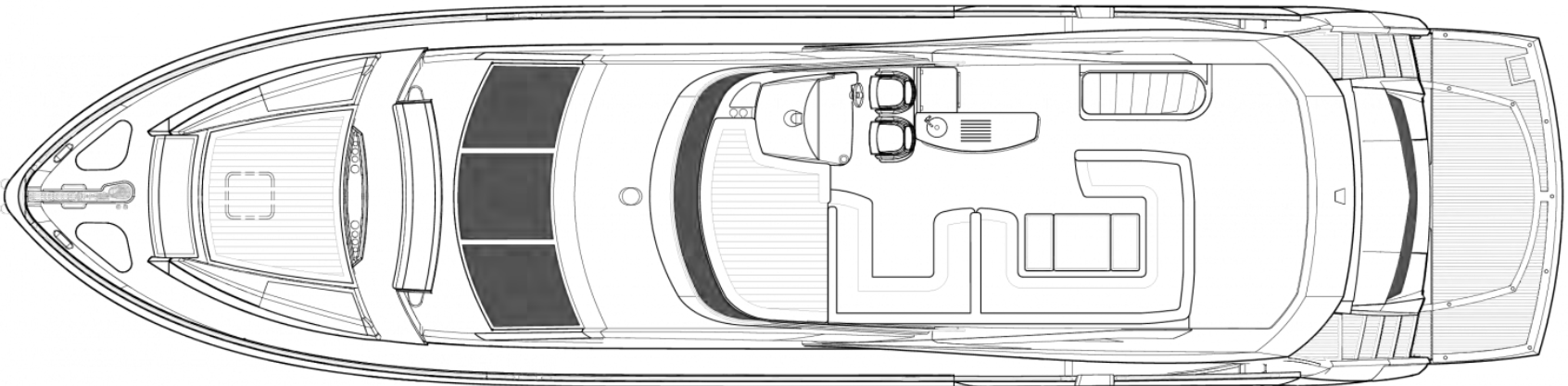
